What to do with the money?

Cost was increasing by two fold

Idea: Funds to focus on community centers- bathrooms.

High power hand driers-\$800 each saving about \$1000 in paper towels annually

Bathroom will be fixed again- without major renovation to the walls

Maybe about \$5000 to \$6000 for the total cost of tow bathrooms.

Idea: \$20,000-30,000 for the lighting in the community centers- exterior lighting around CTC. An evaluation is being done by Deb Edwards, from Lighting Matters to show us how best to replace the lighting in the building.

Lighting Matters will cost about \$4900 for her service- which includes, managing the project Vivek will be reviewing the plan when it is ready.

It was brought up that we ask the consultant to evaluate and give an estimate cost for the lighting in one bedrooms?

Question- should we do something more direct for the members of the community-now that the picnic shelters are not being used, what else can we do so people can see it (\$50,000 is the budget)

Idea: Add more barbecue places? Work strategically- add to where there are more people.
